





Programs are free, yet require a commitment to engage actively in the peer learning community by coming prepared to participate, attending most sessions in a series, and sharing case presentations and ideas with the group.

Through ECHO's online learning networks, health professionals gain the expertise and support they need to address community health needs and care for clients who have complex health conditions, regardless of geographic location or access to specialty care. Past participants have experienced 1) increased confidence in their ability to offer specialty care for common, complex conditions; 2) increased job satisfaction; 3) reduced sense of isolation; and 4) improved ability to use best practices when caring for patients and clients.
